To whom it may concern,

Steven Harrell has been under the care of my office for six years. Today I saw Mr. Harrell for a follow up visit of his sinuses. Patient has been experiencing continuous nasal and sinus infections. He has been prescribed multiple antibiotics, without success. After reviewing his chart and evaluating his symptoms with a CT scan, I have concluded that Mr. Harrell needs sinus surgery due to ongoing, chronic sinus infections in all eight of the primary sinus cavities. He should continue to use his sound prototype device and sinus rinses to reduce inflammation prior to surgery. He has also stated that he cannot drive in the morning due to his sleep disorder. As part of his treatment plan, Mr. Harrell is scheduled for sinus surgery on Wednesday March 1st, after which he will need to recuperate for two weeks before recovering in full.
